Information overflow: information comes from unexpected contexts, and becomes fragmented

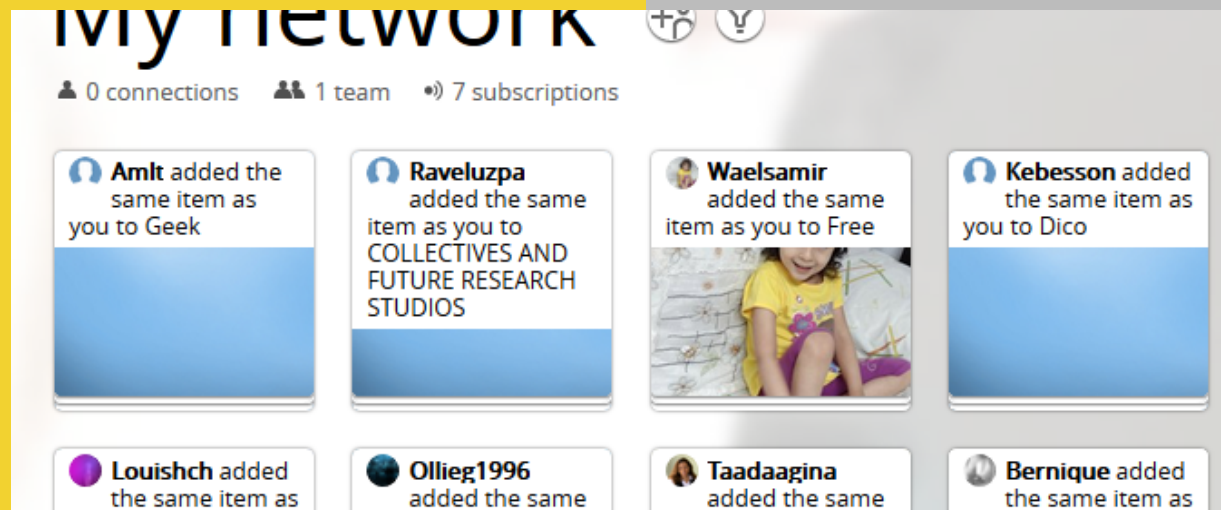

Pearltrees: exploration based on people with similar interests

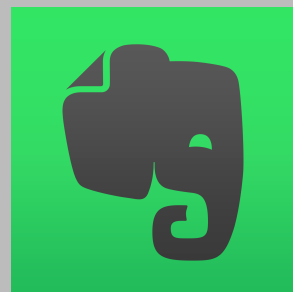


Feedly: exploration based on news channels

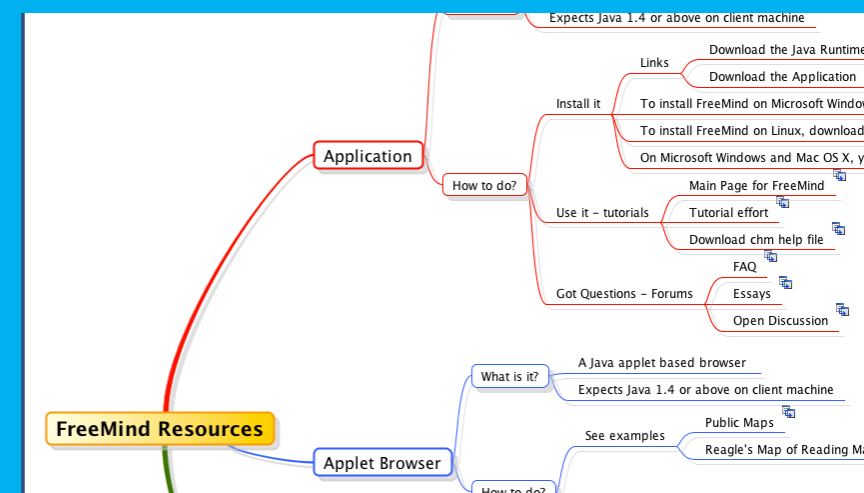
Design thinking toolsets

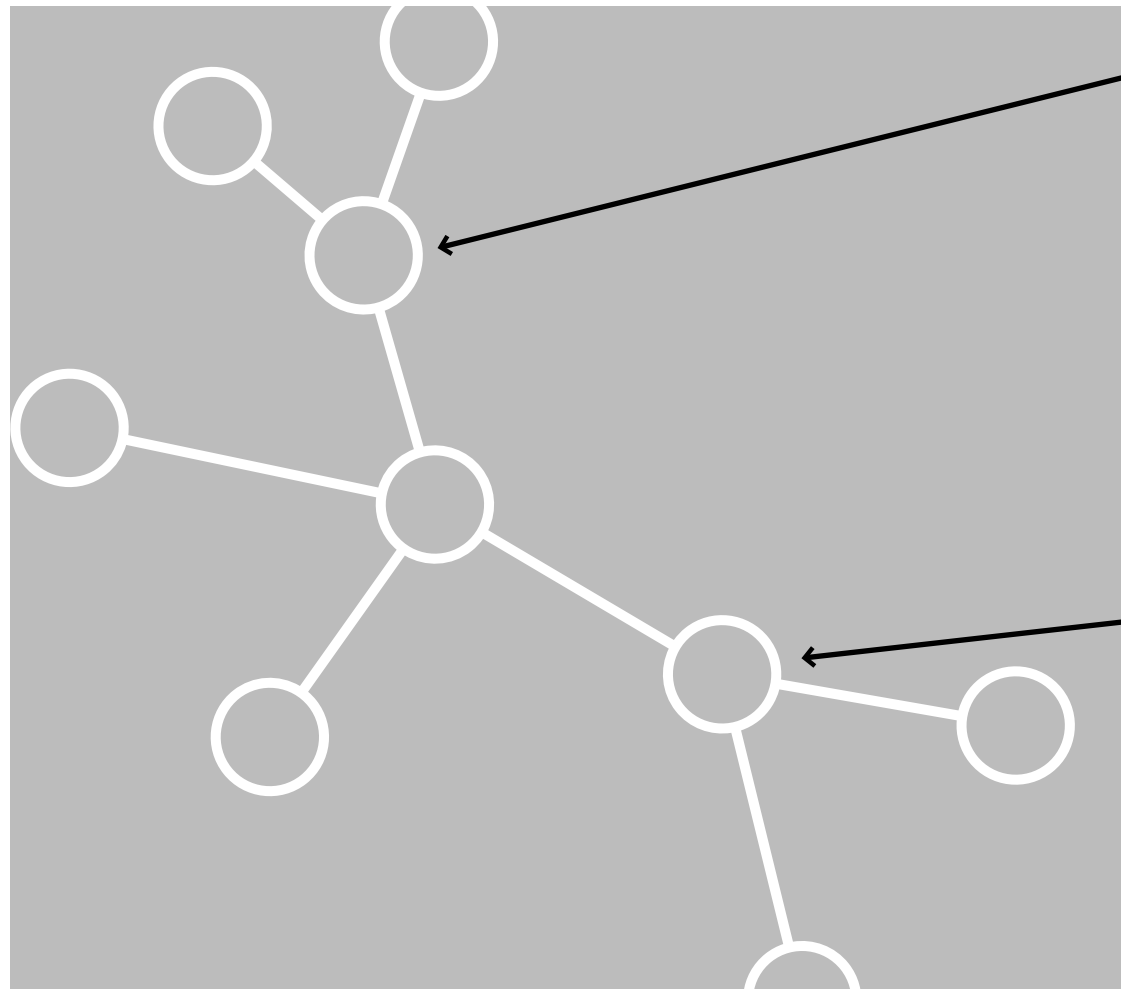
Freemind: allows creation and improvisation of mindmaps

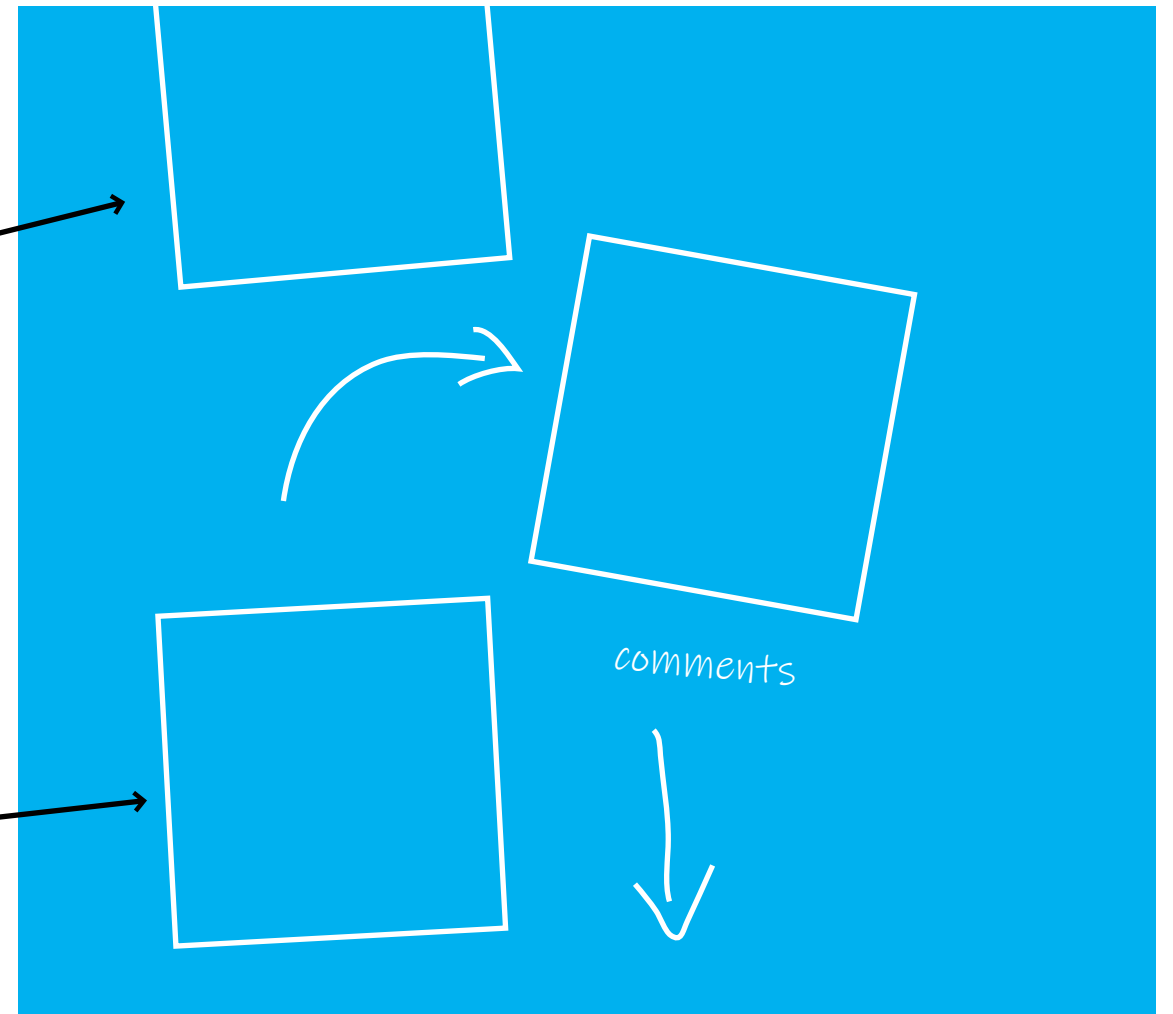
# Concept

Library: place to interrelate



- Storage of collected items & boards
- Items can be found by their relation to others, or by tags

Board: place to reflect



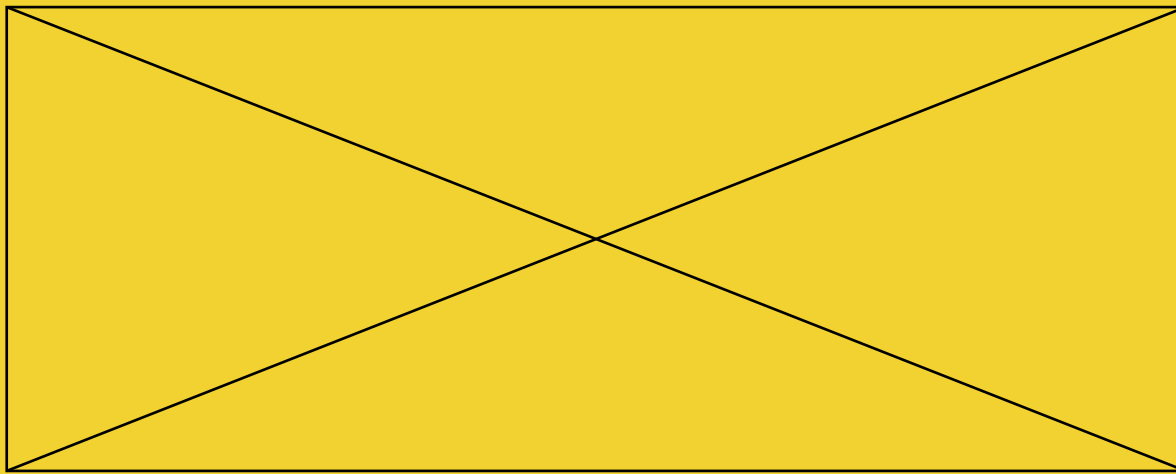
- Is an analogy of a whiteboard
- Items are placed from the library or directly applied in the board

Writing feed   Office feed   JavaScript feed

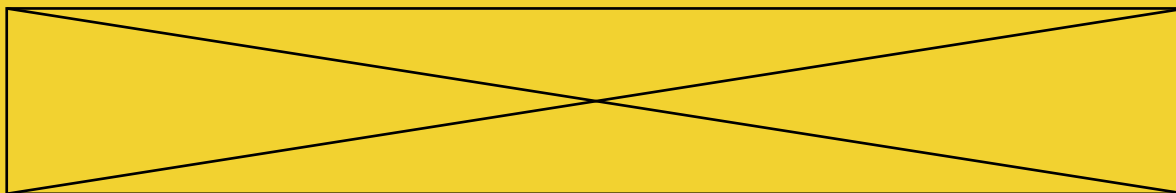
## Design-related feed

A new story from a blog you follow



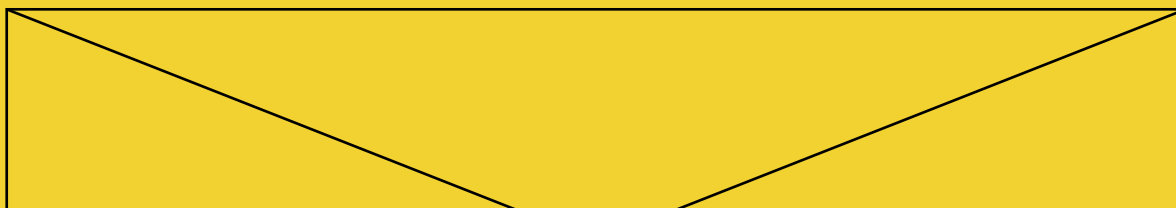
Your friend wants to find a new inspiration to draw
